We have been excited about the toys in the garden especially the push car which has been very popular with the children and with that we are learning to share, take turns and wait patiently. Some of us have been focusing on fine motor skills this week by learning to insert pipe cleaners into a strainer, it's a little tricky at first but with practise we will be able to be master this activity. We also had fun in the sun and enjoyed the warm weather playing with the sand and using water paint to make marks on the wooden panels in the playground. We look forward to another fun filled week.

A word from Danielle in the 2-4 Room

This week, we have enjoyed the addition of some new toys in the nursery, including a new drill and hammer set, allowing us to work on our fine motor skills, as well as negotiating and taking turns with different parts of the set. We followed instructions to make our own playdough, combining the ingredients together and then had fun rolling, squeezing and making dinosaur footprints in the dough. We explored freezing and melting, by putting small toy animals into pots, pouring water inside and leaving in the freezer and checking on them regularly to find out if the water had frozen yet. Using our problem-solving skills we thought of different ways to rescue the animals. Outside, we have been developing our gross motor skills, pedalling using the bike, kicking and throwing balls to each other, using the bricks to create a house and a tall tower, which we enjoyed knocking over!
