#### ... in the 0-2 Room

This week we have been developing our communication and language skills and physical development skills by following instructions to make playdough. We have been identifying the different ingredients and following simple instructions, such as 'pour' and 'mix' to make the playdough. We have also loved listening and singing to our favourite nursery rhymes and songs and matching the animals with their sounds.

We have been speaking lots about the weather this week and the changes we have noticed, and how to dress ourselves appropriately for outdoor play. Earlier in the week, we collected leaves, which we have used to create leaf silhouettes using paint. We were also very excited by the snow this week; for many of us, this was our first-time seeing snow! We have enjoyed the addition of some new outdoor equipment, in the form of tyres, wooden blocks and planks, which we are looking forward to getting creative with over the coming weeks. We have loved playing with sea animals in the nursery, so created our own sea life tray by colouring rice blue and adding some sea creatures, rocks and shells, and using a non-fiction book 'The Big Book of the Blue' to find out facts about our favourite sea creatures. We ended the week by following instructions to bake banana bread for dessert and make homemade pizzas for lunch!
